OBITUARY

HOWARD L. DENNISON, son of the late Howard O. Dennison and Laura M. Dennison was born on March 29, 1936 in Havre de Grace, Maryland. He departed this life on Thursday, January 28, 2021 at his home in Baltimore, Maryland.

He received his education from the Havre de Grace Consolidated High School in 1954. He received a bachelor's degree from Morgan State College in 1958. Howard loved to run track in high school and college. He was part of a Championship Team at the Penn Relays. Upon graduating from Morgan, he entered the United States Army and became a military police officer.

He was later employed at the Rockland State Hospital in New York for 4 years, the Maryland Penitentiary for 5 years and Washington DC Corrections as a Correctional Parole Officers where he later retired as a Supervisory Parole Officer.
