OBITUARY

SETH BROWN was born on December 6, 1941, in Madison, Arkansas and was the sixth of nine children born to the union of Cora Sandford-Brown and Sommie Andrew Brown. Seth entered his eternal home on February 6, 2021 in Queens, New York at the age of 79. He is preceded in death by his parents Sommie Andrew Brown and Cora Sandford Brown, seven siblings Robert, Maudess, Andrew, Earline, Earnestine, Billie, and Rudy.

As a child Seth attended Madison Light Baptist Church and there accepted Jesus as his Lord and Savior.
