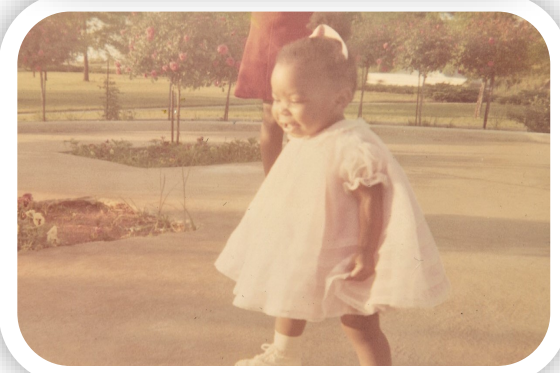
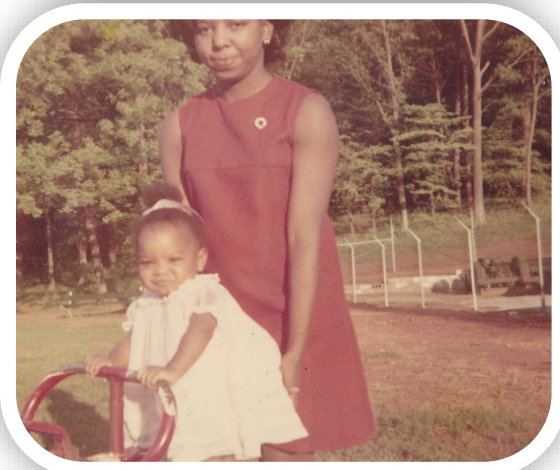


## *I MISS YOU, MOM*
