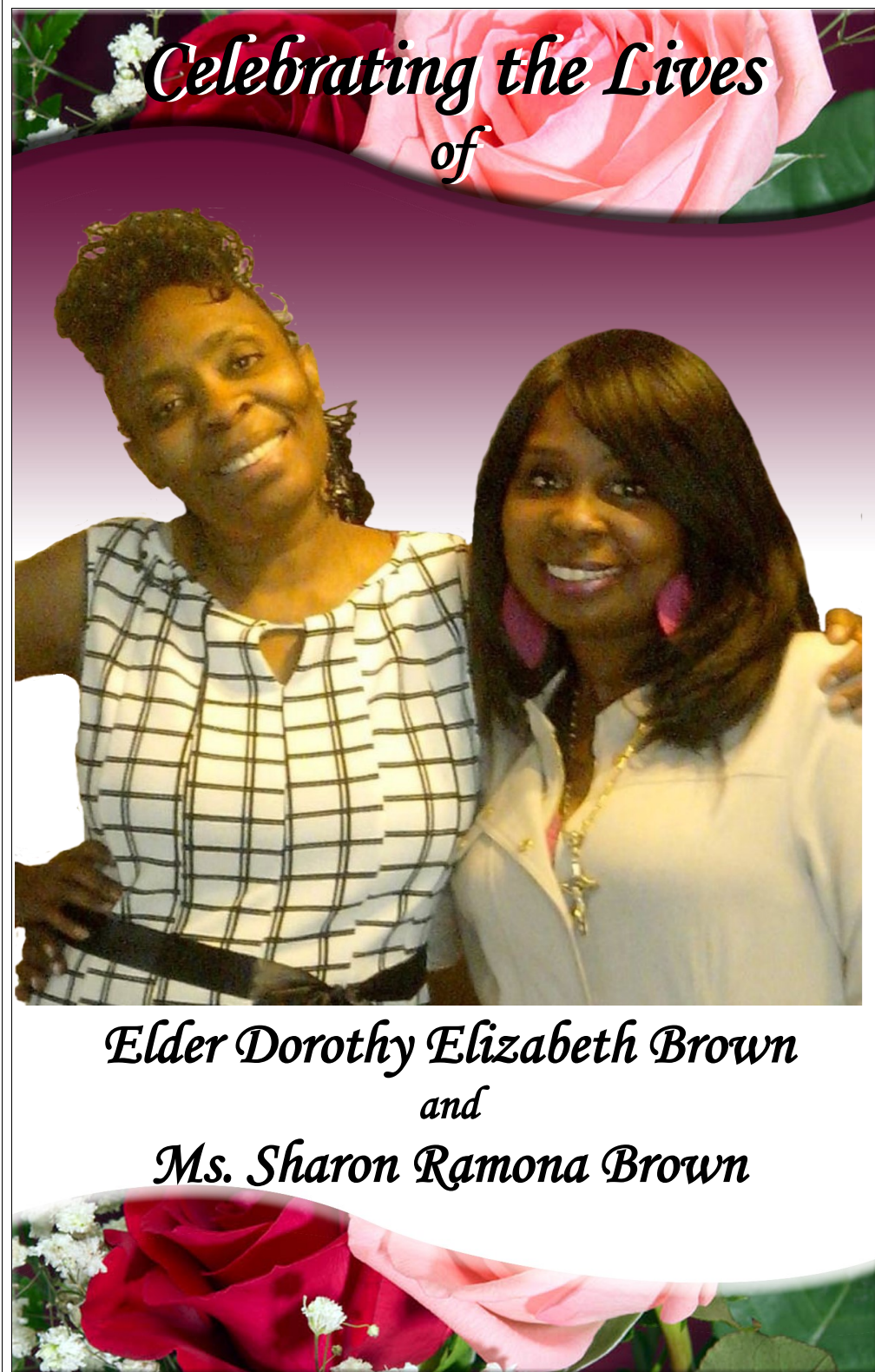

## *Never Forgotten*

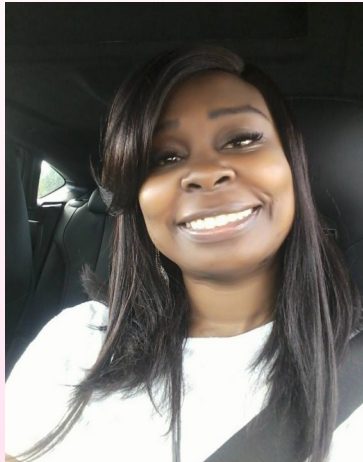
You all will never be forgotten,
