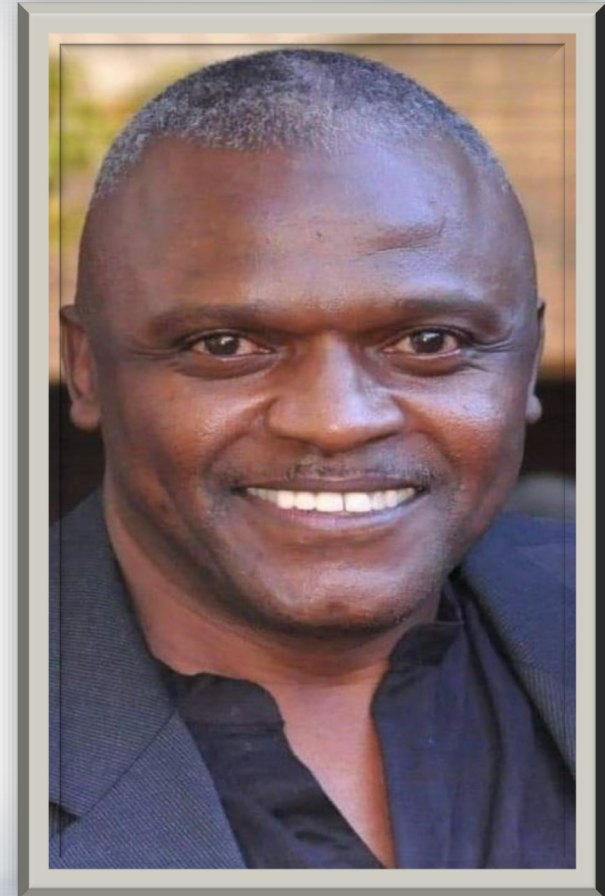

## Obituary
