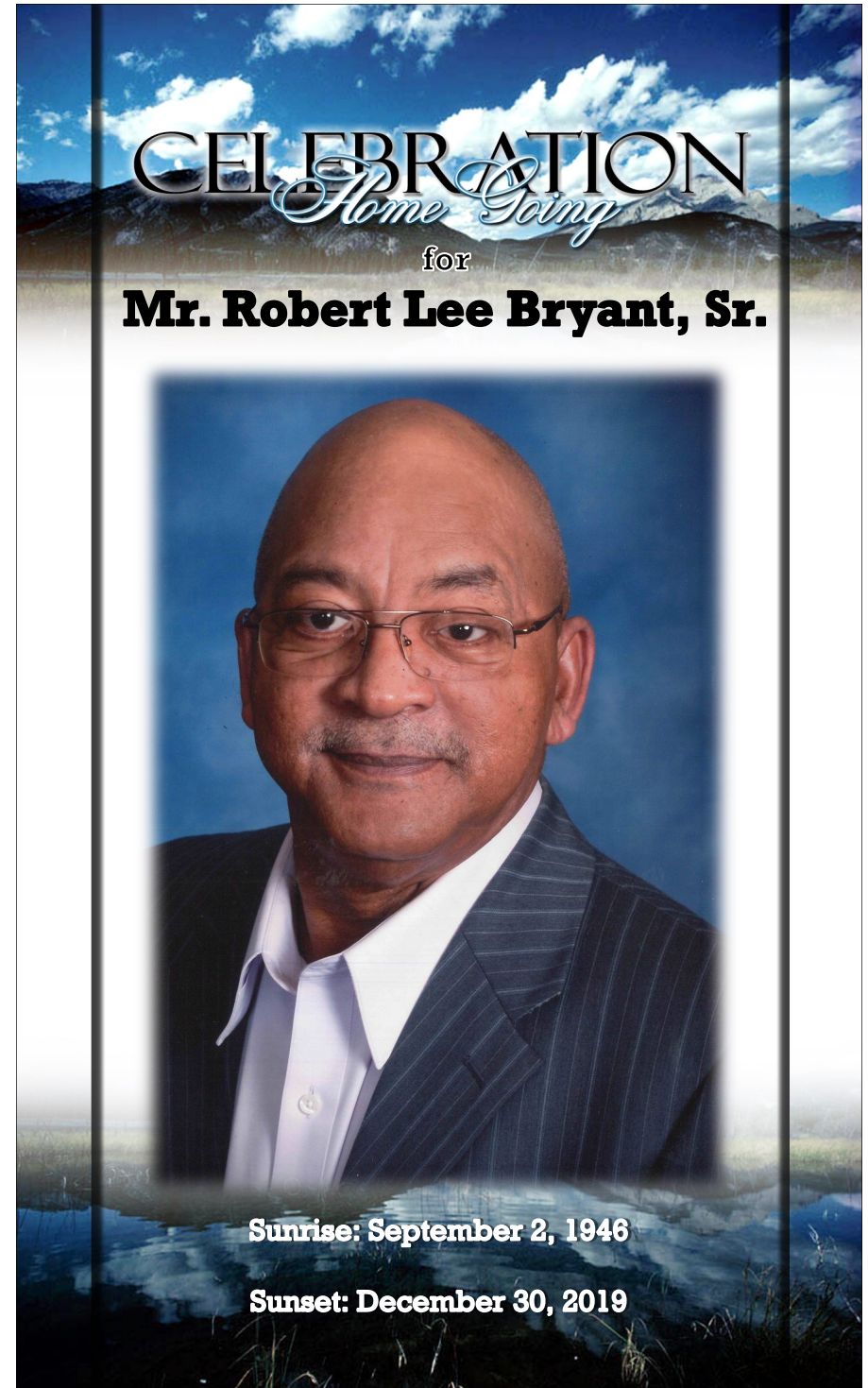
**Weep Not for Me**
