BROTHER TRAVIS ISAIAH “TRAP” ANDERSON

It was the 111th day of the year when God blessed David Anderson and Velma Elaine Holcomb Anderson with the birth of their son, **Travis Isaiah Anderson** on Wednesday, April 21, 1982 in Spartanburg, South Carolina. Active, inquisitive, and vibrant are appropriate descriptions for the boy-child who would become a young man known as the “smiling face to light up the place.” Laughter was his signature and kindness became his hallmark throughout the days of his life. “**TRAP**” was the nickname he gained – probably because he could trap anyone into the warmth of his heart, even in the cold realities of this world.
