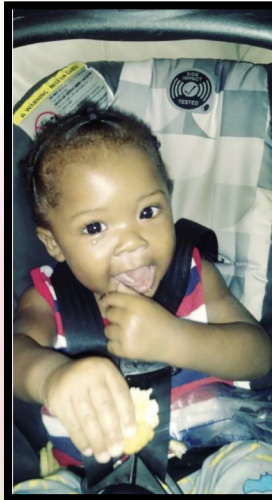


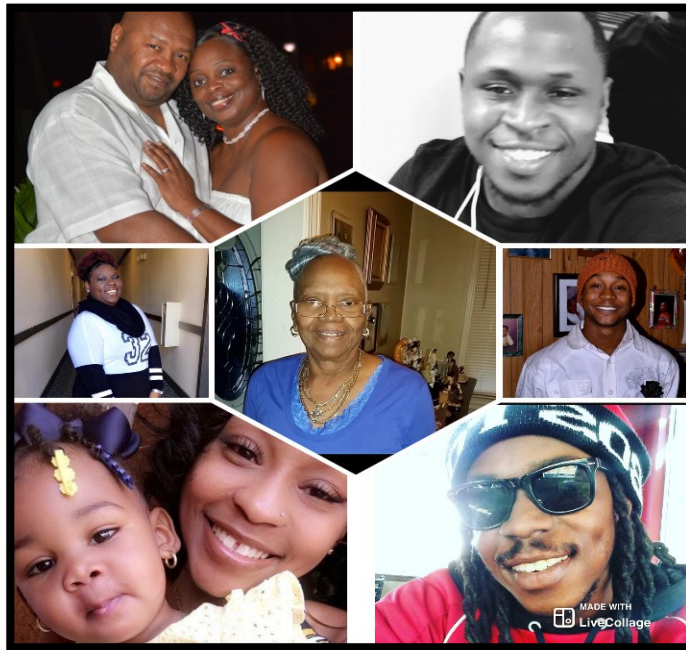
God's Angel
