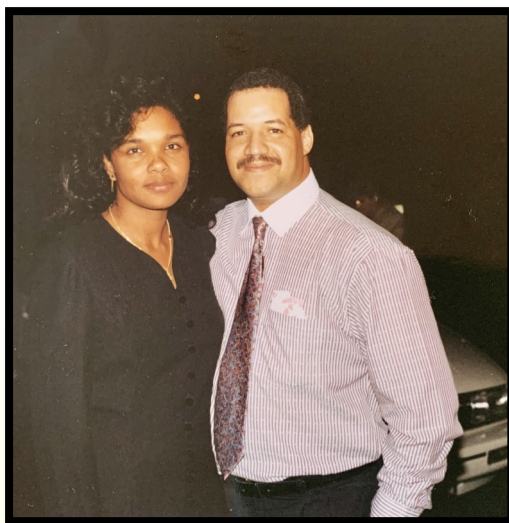


Dearest Debbie,

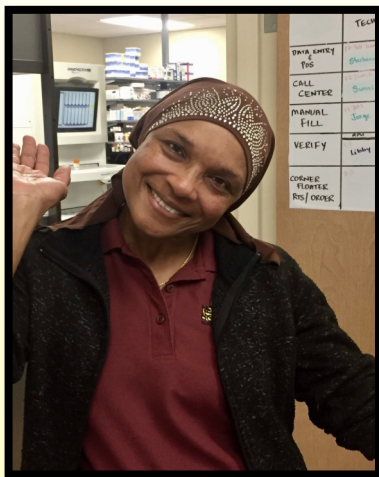
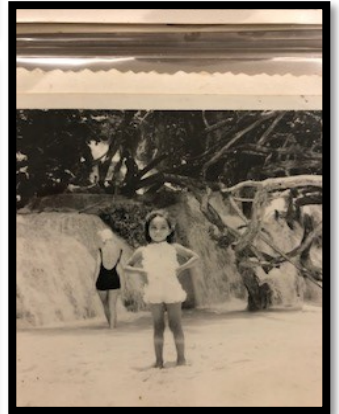

I wouldn't be the man I am today, without you.

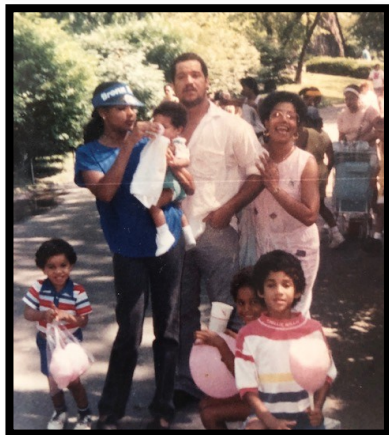

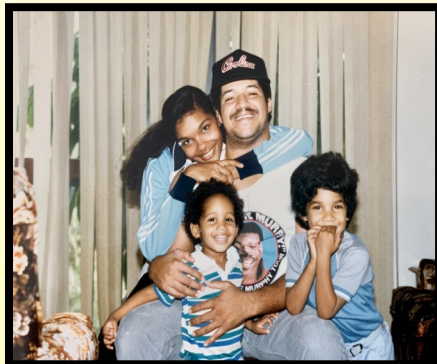




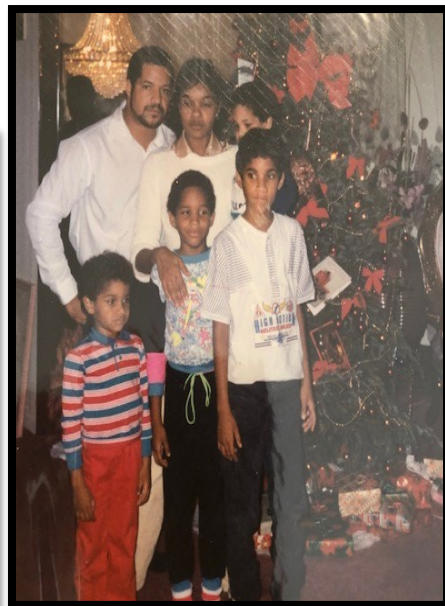
























## *Safely Home*
