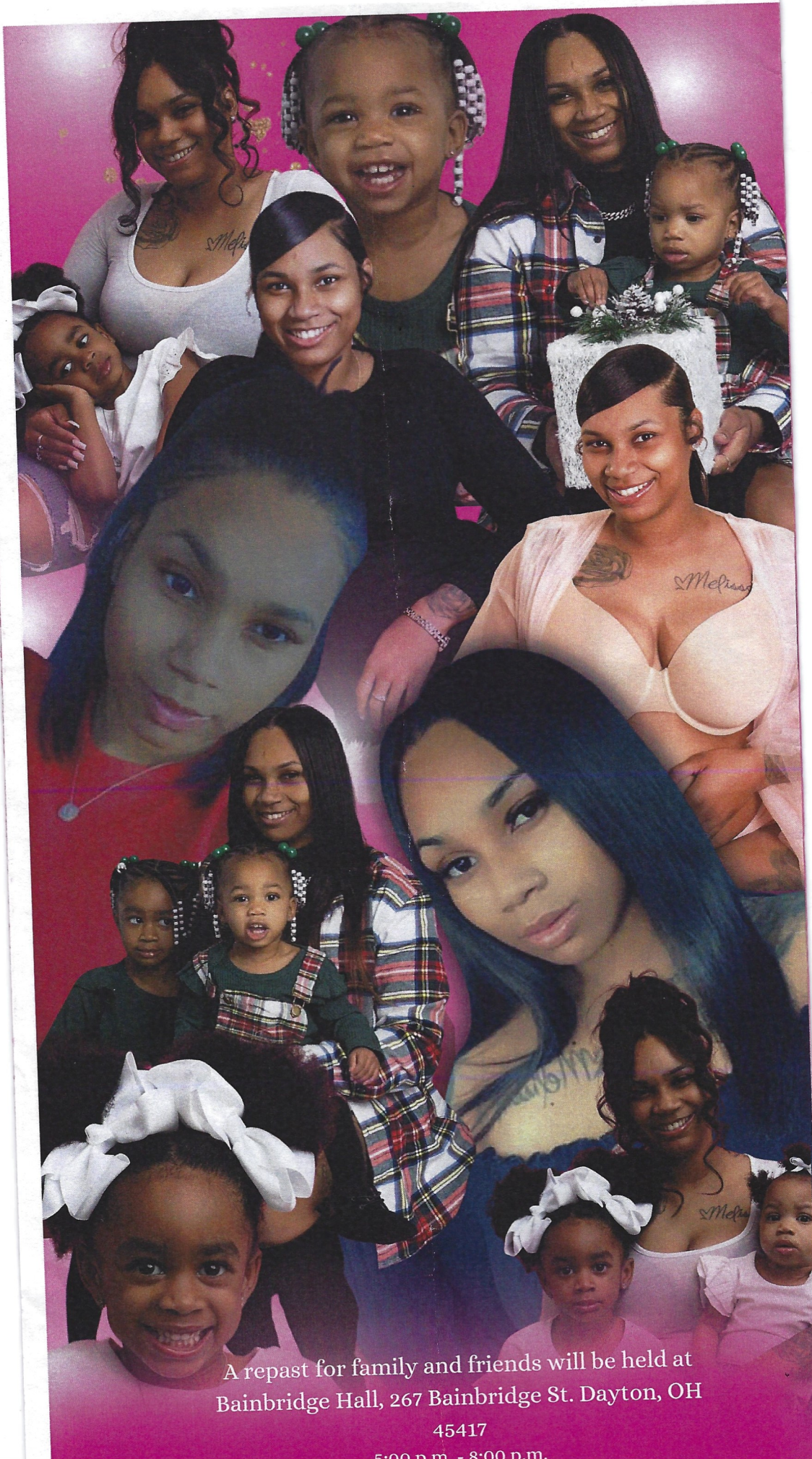

girls, family and friends. Her love was unconditional.

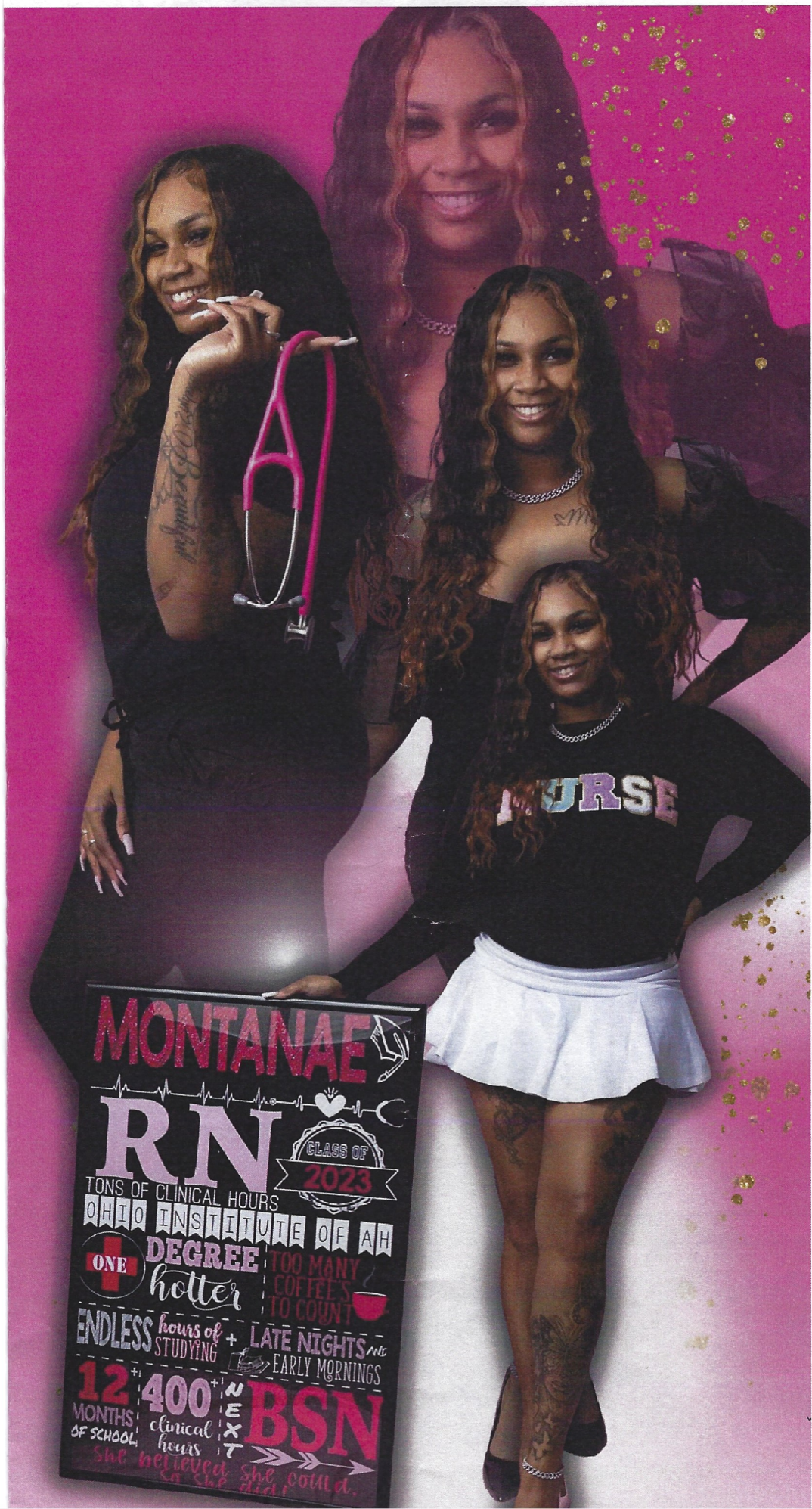
Montanae graduated from Thurgood Marshall High School in 2015.
