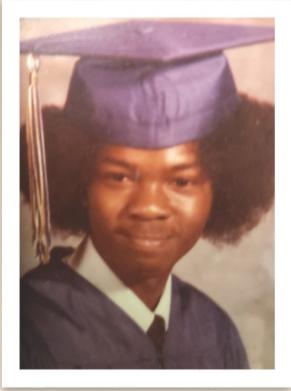

Obituary

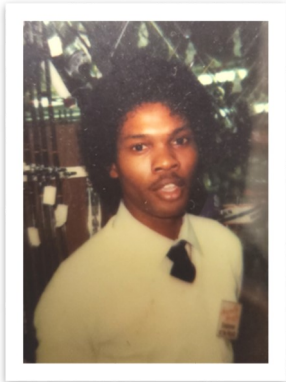


William Gowen Peterson was a devoted father, grandfather, and friend. He was born on May 31st, 1959 in West Palm Beach, Florida.
