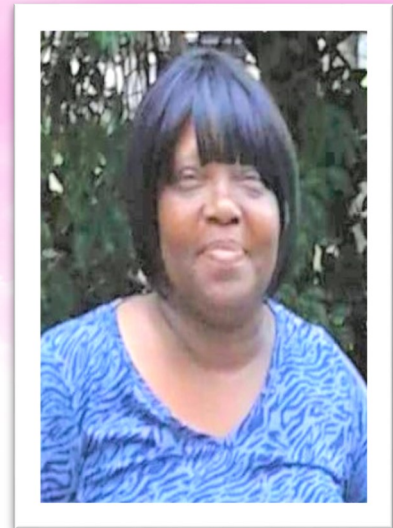

# Obituary

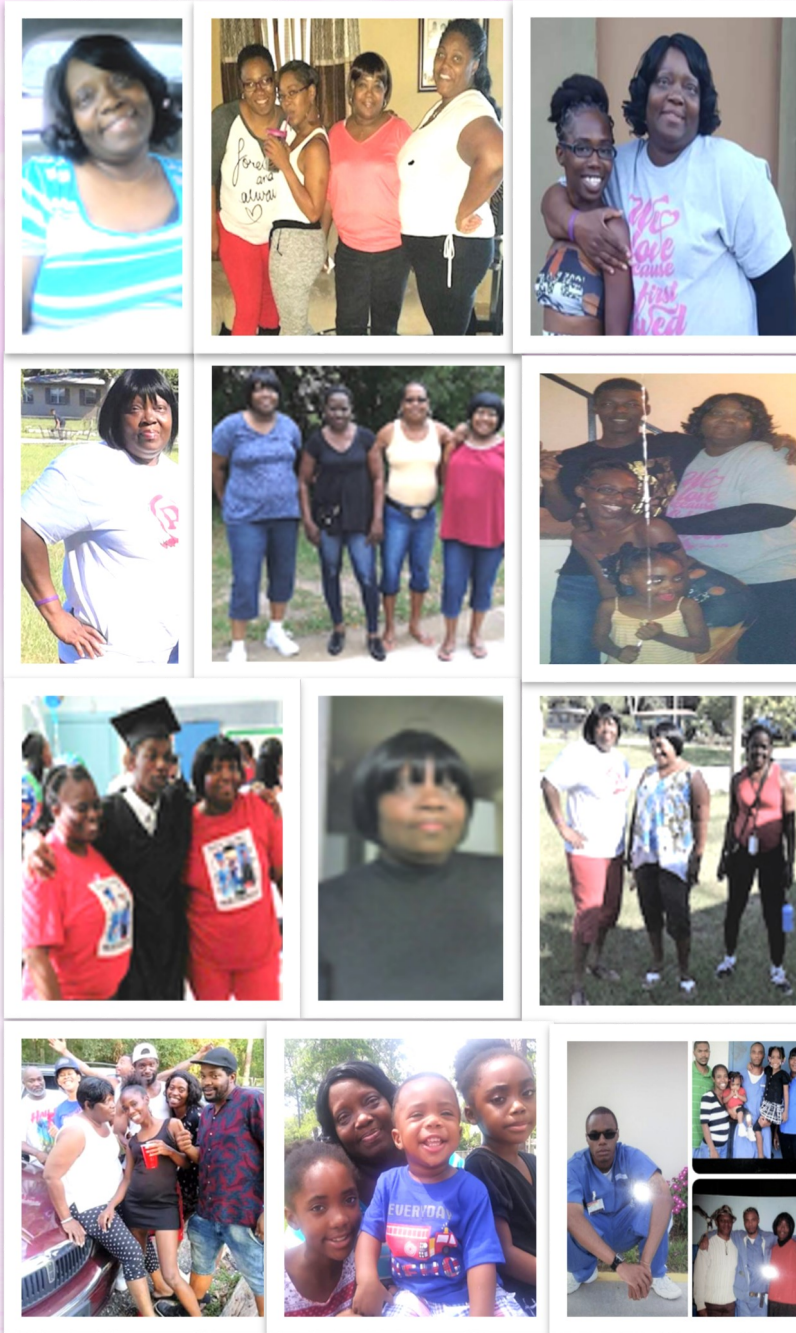
*To everything there is a season, a time for every purpose under heaven: a time to be born, and a time to die. Ecclesiastes 3: 1-2*
